We have had confirmation from the photographer that school photos will be ready after the holidays.



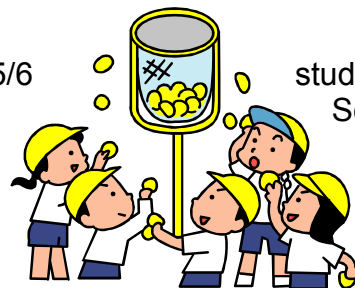
## Staffing Changes
